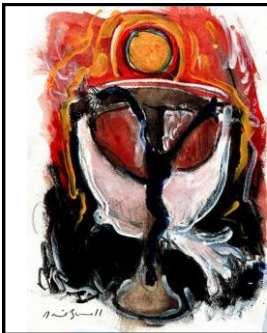
And we are His portion and He is our prize,
